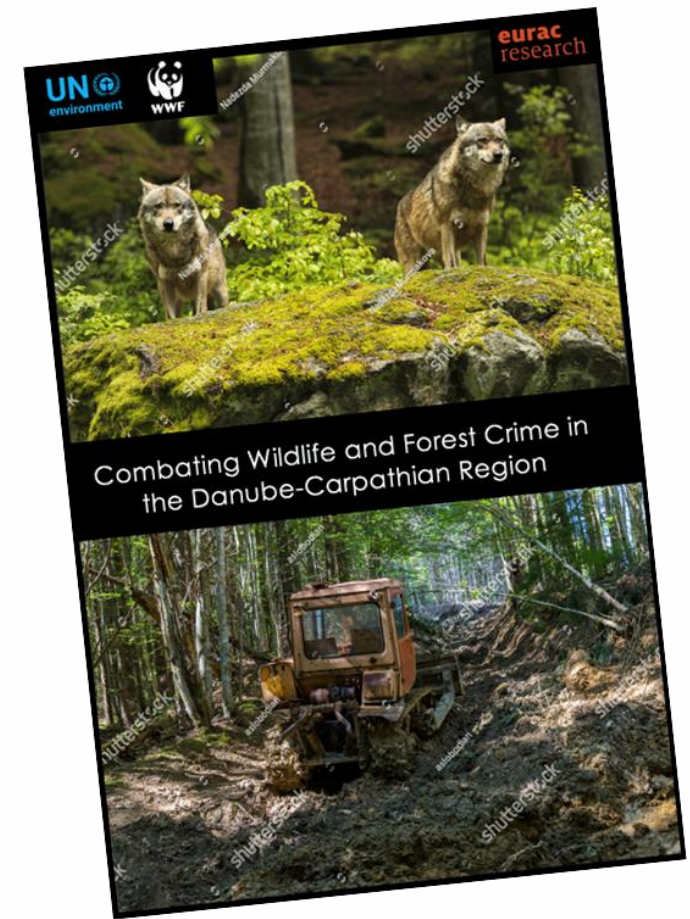
Large carnivores – Action Plan for the conservation and sustainable management for the Carpathian populations of large carnivores

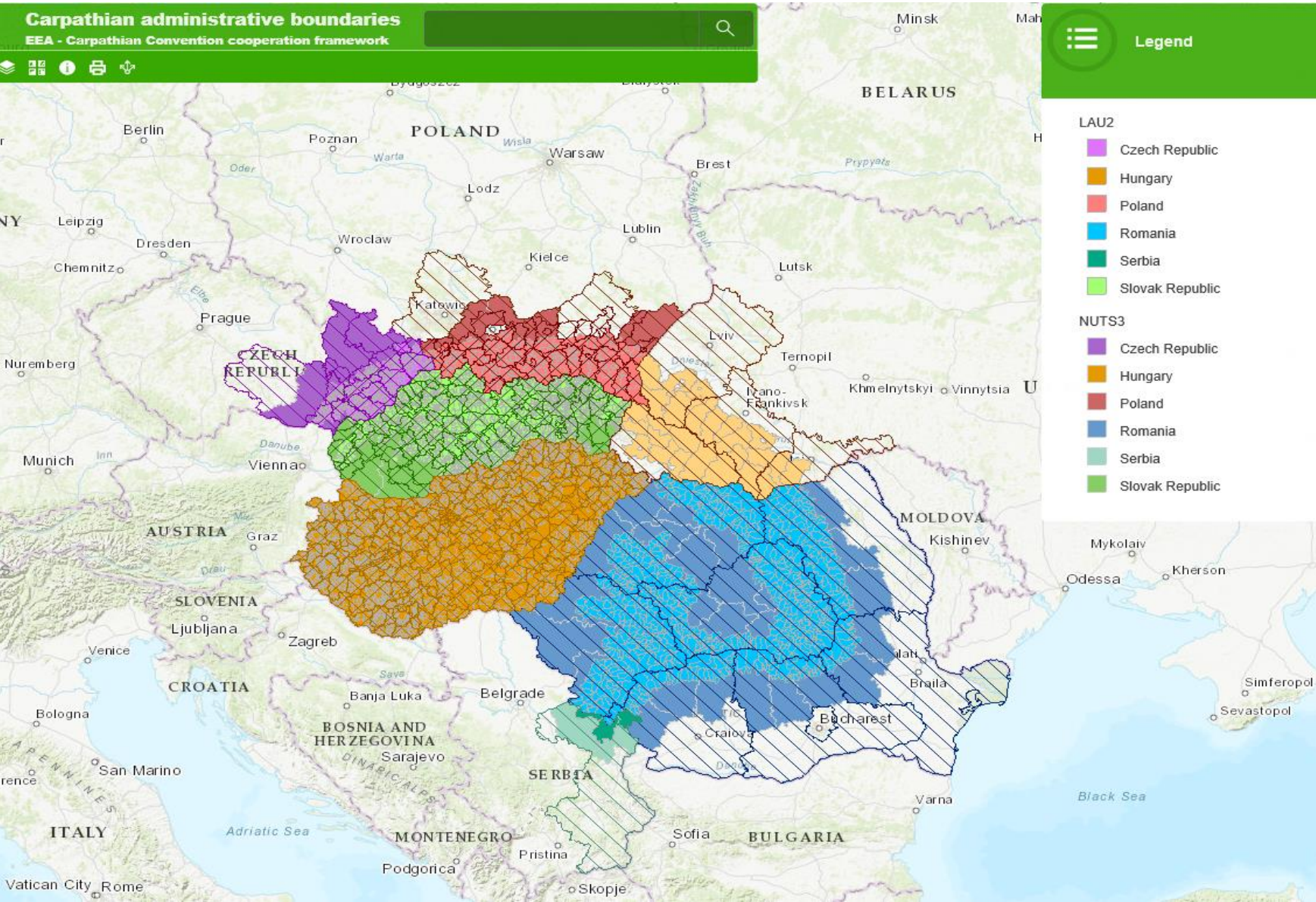

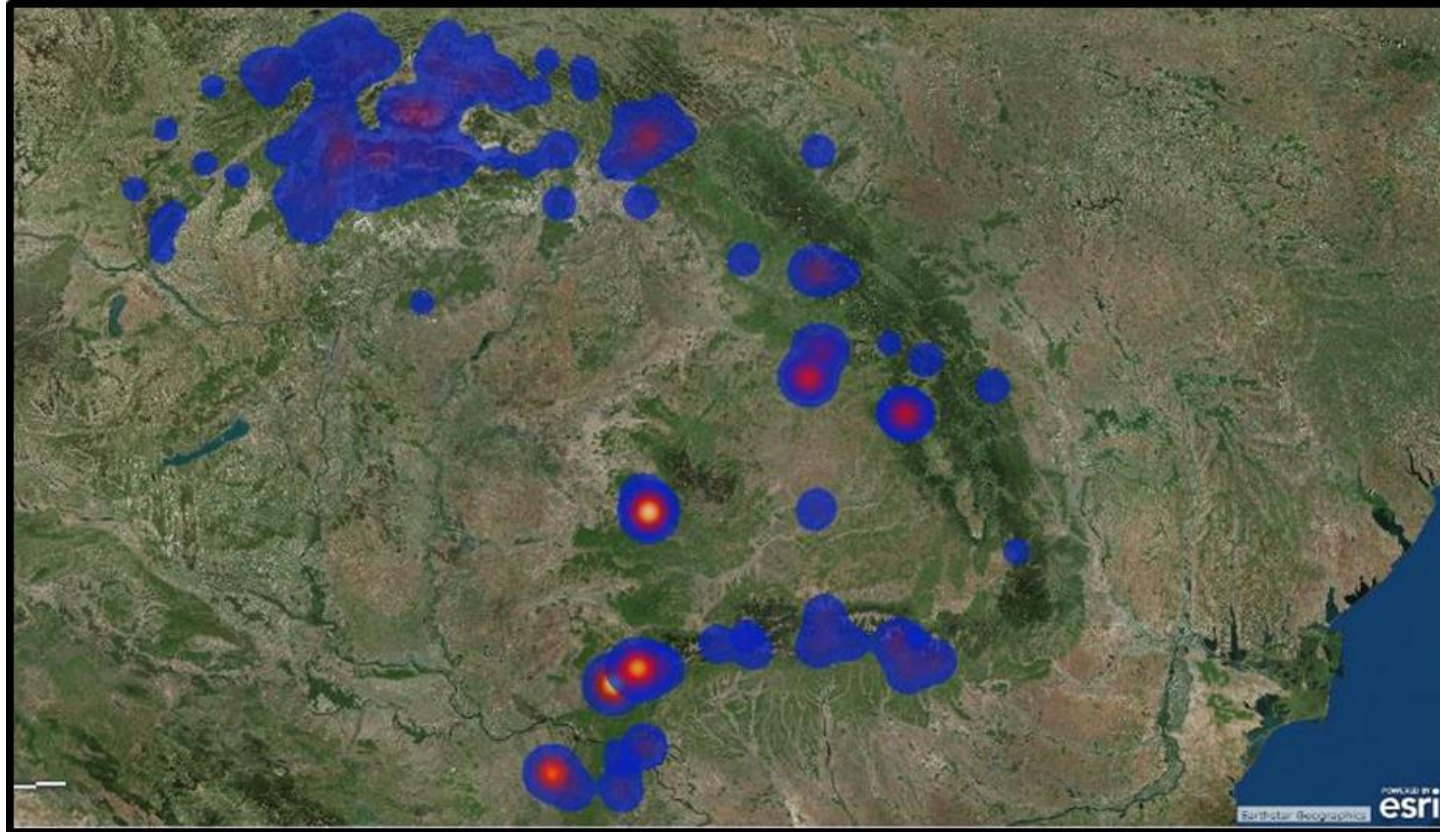

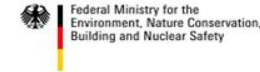
